Eastwood, Jefferson each win meet titles

EL PASO — With more than 200 runners in each race, the top-ranked Jefferson boys and Eastwood girls cross country teams stood tall at the inaugural Clint ISD Invitational at Emerald Springs Golf Course in a rare Friday evening meet.

Hours after a storm drenched the course with rain, Jefferson was able to take its second win of the season by placing three runners in the Top 10. Led by Joel Flores (fourth), Eli Hernandez (seventh) and Alex Acuña (eighth), the city's No. 1-ranked Silver Foxes were first with 69 points.

No. 2 Montwood was second with 106 points, followed by No. 4 Horizon with 110. There were 15 teams in the race.


Individually, the race belonged to Eastwood's Juan Blanco, who overcame 264 other runners and completed the 5K course in 16 minutes, 5.28 seconds. He held off Horizon's Adrian Anaya, who was second in 16:06.97 and Montwood's Angel De La Cruz (16:15.96), who was third.

The girls race, which also was a 5K race, went to Horizon's duo of Sonia Vasquez (19:24.78) and Vanessa Moreno (19:33:59), who were first and second.

While their finish helped lead the No. 2 Scorpions to 67 points, it was not enough, as No. 1 Eastwood won with 54 points. The Troopers were led by Elyssa Garcia, who placed third with a time of 19:43.79.

Clint was third out of 14 teams with 87 points.



Runners: a different breed of athlete

There is no satisfying a cross country runner.

Either the number of miles or the amount of pain; none of it is enough for them. That is why they do what they do — run.

Cross country runners are a different breed of athlete altogether.

For starters, it takes a great deal of time and effort to run more miles in one hour than some drive in a day. If a three-mile race sounds tough, then you don't want to even begin to hear what these kids do in a "light" practice.

When you're outside watering your lawn or even going for a nice, easy jog, they are those teens who fly past you at full speed. You may think to that they are either just running down the street or that they might get tired and slow down soon.


Either way, you are wrong. They plan on keeping that pace for a long time.

Most of all, when they finish a workout, somewhere deep down in the back of their minds, they still feel like doing more. In fact, they know they could do more and want to.

It's not easy, but then no sport ever really is. Pain is a part of any sport, but for the runner it is unavoidable and they welcome it.

It's not about how much pain they can take and keep going, it's more about how much they want to take it.

That is why sometimes they have to be told, if not forced to understand, by



parents, trainers and coaches that even though they are used to pushing their limits, they cannot run with a concussion, the flu or a fractured leg.

It's definitely not the most popular sport, so you're not going to see a clip of a team placing all five runners in the Top 10 on "Sportscenter."

Also, a two- or three-mile course through desert, hills, parks or a school parking lot is not the easiest to keep up with, even if you try to follow in a car or dirt bike.

State champions in cross country don't garner as much attention around campus as the football team does, but once again, that doesn't matter. To them, an early Saturday morning race in the freezing rain or in the sizzling sun is as marquee an event as a Friday night football game under stadium lights.

Several of their fellow students may only know them as, "Hey, you're that kid who is always running when I'm leaving school."

Most importantly for these athletes, cross country isn't just a sport, it's the sport for them.

It has the ability to take natural runners and give them a challenge, while at the same time giving others with more determination than talent a chance to finally prove themselves.

They don't need a crowd, band or cheerleaders. Motivation can come in the form of loved ones, friendship, a favorite song or phrase while they navigate a course.

At the end of the day, or at the end of a career, the cross country runner still is not done. Inside of them there is one more great mile just waiting to get out. No matter what they do, it will always be there, because it never is enough.

EL PASO — At one point this season, Eastwood High School cross country runner Melanie Stires considered herself "the slowest one on the team."

Looking back, that seems almost ridiculous.

Fully healthy and running strategically Saturday, the Trooper junior won the District 1-5A girls championships after traversing the Chamizal Park's 2-mile course in 12 minutes, 58.67 seconds.

Garcia considers this season's edition of the Troopers to be unique.

"We did a lot of team bonding, actually," she said. "In the previous years, we were kind of like, 'Oh, you're my teammate,' but this year, we really got close."

EL PASO — It's no secret the start of the high school cross country season doesn't raise the same fervor as the first weekend of football.

"We just want to come in together," Garcia said.

One runner who will be looking to come in solo is Coronado senior Diane Bocklage, who is the top returning girl from last year.

With the departure of Marissa Paz and Sandra Walker, Bocklage will battle it out with Chapin High School senior Adriana DeLeon and Del Valle High School junior Maria Esquinca in the girls division.

"I'm looking forward to district, because I want to perform better than last year," Bocklage, the District 1-5A runner-up, said. "I'm sure there's going to be some good runners this year, but its seems like I got a good chance to win district."

In only her second year, Bocklage, like so many other newcomers, has grown to embrace the sport.

"It's a really grueling sport," she said. "Some days, you finish the race and feel like you accomplished something."

Coaching tree bears success

EL PASO — Mike McLain, Howard Prestwood and Chris Gee are three of the area's most successful cross country coaches, and success isn't the only thing they have in common.

Each is a graduate of Hanks High School, each loves the sport they coach and each gives a great deal of credit for what they have achieved to their mentor and former high school coach, Paul Pearson.

"Coach Pearson is a mentor to all of us," said Gee, who heads the Class 3A Clint High School girls team, which is ranked No. 1 in the city. "He helped guide me in the right direction."

Gee graduated in 1990 and, like Prestwood, didn't run cross country in high school, but rather played football and ran track. Pearson coached both of them in track and field, and he has remained close with them.

In fact, when Prestwood returned to Clint in 2000, he thought he was going to coach football. Instead, he wound up coaching cross country and later was hired at Horizon, where he now is the head coach of the county's top Class 4A girls team.

"Coach Pearson teaches more than just workouts. He teaches about life, pursuing dreams and pursuing goals," said Prestwood, a 1986 Hanks graduate.

Pearson himself was quite a runner before turning to coaching. The 58-year-old native of Canada attended UTEP on a running scholarship and turned his attention to coaching in the area.


"It's great seeing them achieving so much," Pearson said of his protégés.

McClain is the head coach at Eastwood, and his girls are the city's top 5A team. He also credits Pearson.

4 Eastwood Graduates qualify for 2009 Cross Country National Championships






